CTG Launches Broadband Speed Test for New York State Residents

CTG is partnering with the New York State Office of Cyber Security (OCS) on a broadband testing and mapping project funded by a grant from the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA). The overall goal is to develop a comprehensive map of broadband internet availability throughout New York State. CTG's role in the project is to develop the broadband speed test tool and website, recruit New York State residents to take the test, and collect and analyze the data.
